

# CALF SCRAMBLE PROGRESS SHOW RULES

## 1. Registration:

- a. Heifers entered in this show must be registered in the records of their respective breed association (in the name of the exhibitor). **Registration papers must be on file in the Calf Scramble Office and heifer exhibitors must present the HLSR stamped copy of the registration papers at check-in.**
- b. Steers entered in this show must have an official and visible Texas Validation ear tag and electronic ID in the steer's ear. **The EID number must be on file in the Calf Scramble Office.**

## 2. Classes:

- a. Heifer classes will be broken by age within three divisions; American, British and European (no individual breed classes).
- b. Steer classes will be broken into 9 classes by WEIGHT ONLY (no breed classification will occur.)

## 3. Heifer Registration Papers:

- a. Exhibitors are required to bring the **STAMPED COPY OF THEIR** registration paper to the show ring and to keep IT in their possession while exhibiting the heifer.

## 4. Animal Health Regulations:

- a. No health certificate required.
- b. A visual inspection will take place during unload.

## 5. Grooming and Equipment:

- a. This is a Blow and Go Show for both heifers and steers. No grooming material, paint or dye is allowed on any animal.
- b. No clippers, which must be plugged into an electrical outlet, are allowed to be used on Scramble Breeding Beef Heifers or Scramble Steers once they arrive on Show grounds. Cordless clippers are allowed.
- c. No show boxes will be allowed in the barn. Be prepared to unload minimal tack upon arrival.
- d. No generators will be allowed in or around the barn.
- e. No fans will be allowed in the barn.

6. The Calf Scramble Progress Show is limited to Scramble and Dairy/Livestock Judging certificate winners only. Winners are only allowed to bring their scramble heifer or scramble steer that is registered with the Calf Scramble Office. No substitute exhibitors are allowed.

7. Dogs are not allowed on Show grounds. This rule will be strictly enforced and applies to all exhibitors and Show visitors. Exceptions are granted for dogs that are individually trained to do work or perform tasks for a person with a disability.

8. Entries must be made online from September 10 to October 1, 2016 through the scramblers monthly reporting system.

9. There is no entry fee.
