

The Terry Foundation Scholarship

The Terry Freshman Scholarship, known as the Terry Traditional Scholarship, is awarded to Texas high school seniors who have been accepted for admission to one of the Terry-affiliated public universities in Texas. Award of the scholarship is based on a student's academics, leadership (evidenced by extra-curricular participation and community service), and financial need. A Terry Traditional Scholarship is a four-year scholarship, renewable annually, and based on the official cost of attendance at each university. The scholarship includes tuition, fees, books, on-campus room and board, and miscellaneous expenses. The actual scholarship amount will vary for each selected Terry Scholar.

The Terry Foundation does not accept applications directly from candidates and instead authorizes our Terry-affiliated university partners to handle that process. *Each of our Terry-affiliated universities conducts its own application process, with its own application and its own deadline.* Applicants must meet the Terry deadline for the university to which they are applying. Candidates who are successful in the university competition will receive a nomination to interview with the Terry Foundation.
