

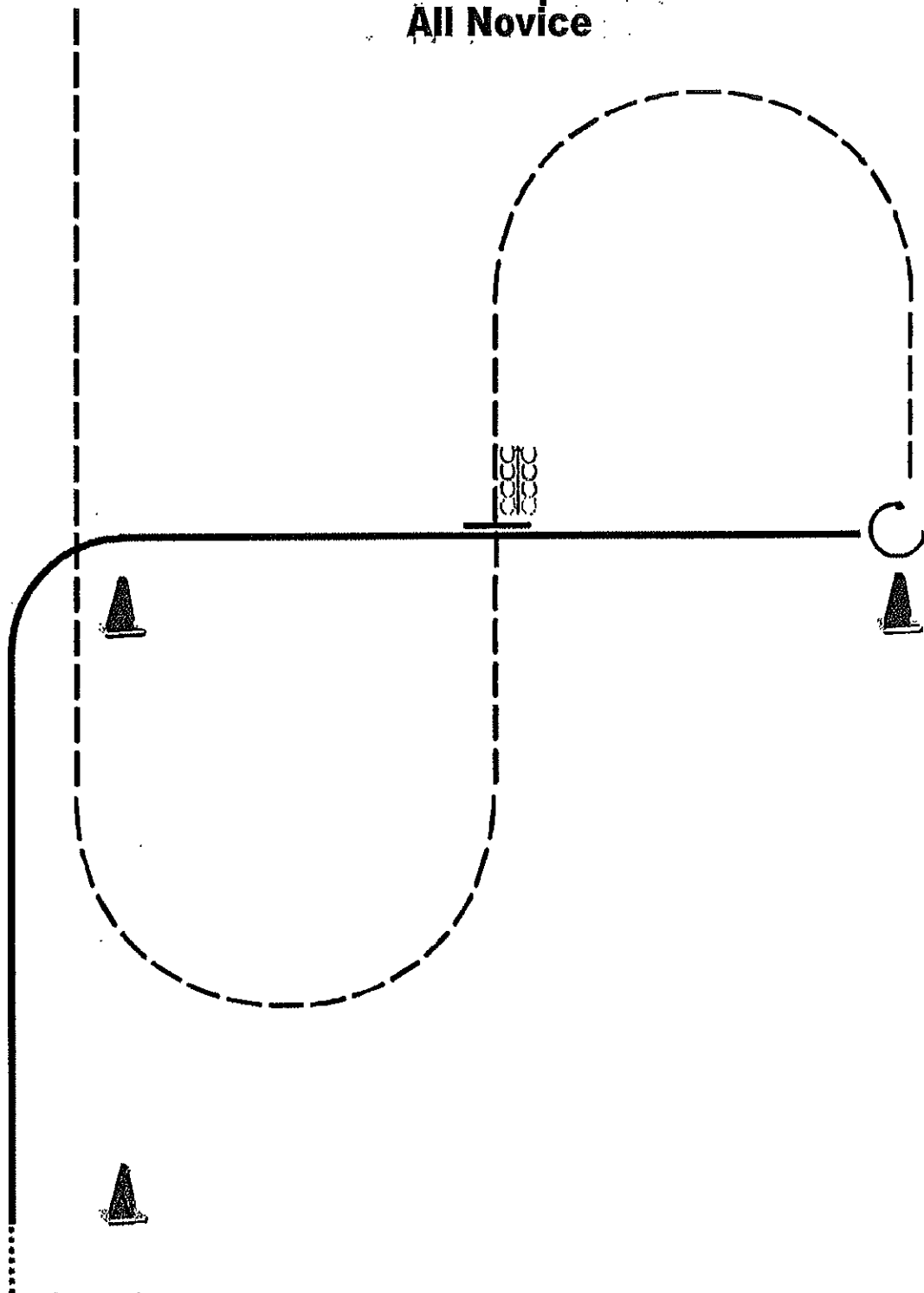

Hunt Seat Equitation All Novice



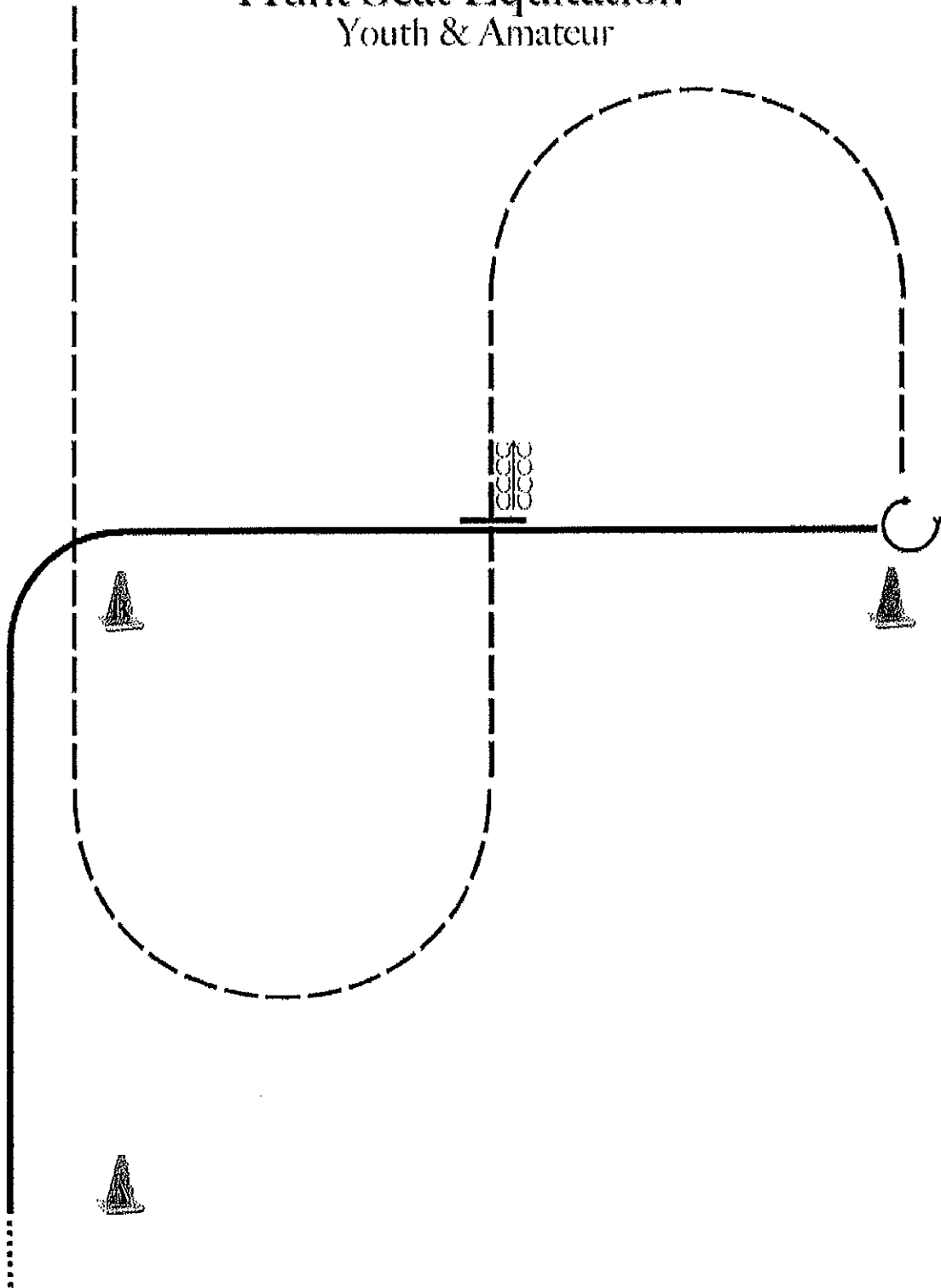
Instructions

- 1) Walk one horse length to A
- 2) Begin on right lead
- 3) Canter around B and continue to C
- 4) At C, Halt and Perform a 270°
forehand turn to the right
- 5) Posting trot right diagonal as shown
- 6) Halt between B and C and back one horse length
- 7) Resume the trot on the left diagonal
- 8) When beside B, exit at the sitting trot

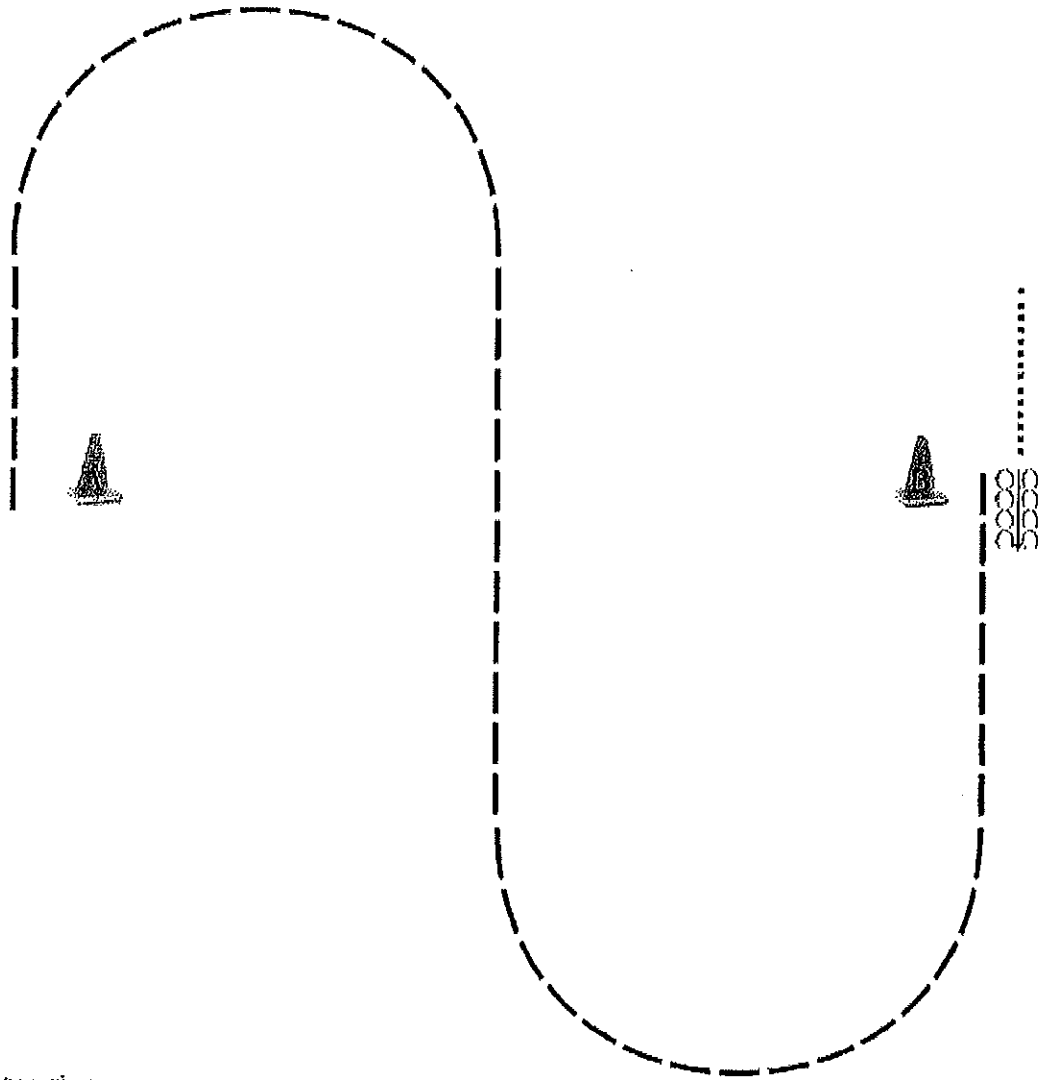
Instructions

- 1) Walk one horse length to A
- 2) Canter left lead around B and continue to C.
- 3) At C, Halt and Perform a 270° forehand turn to the right
- 4) Posting trot right diagonal as shown
- 5) Halt between B and C and back one horse length
- 6) Resume the trot in the 2 point position
- 7) When beside B, exit at the sitting trot

- 3) Continue on the right diagnal to B
- 4) At B, Halt and back
- 5) Exit at a walk

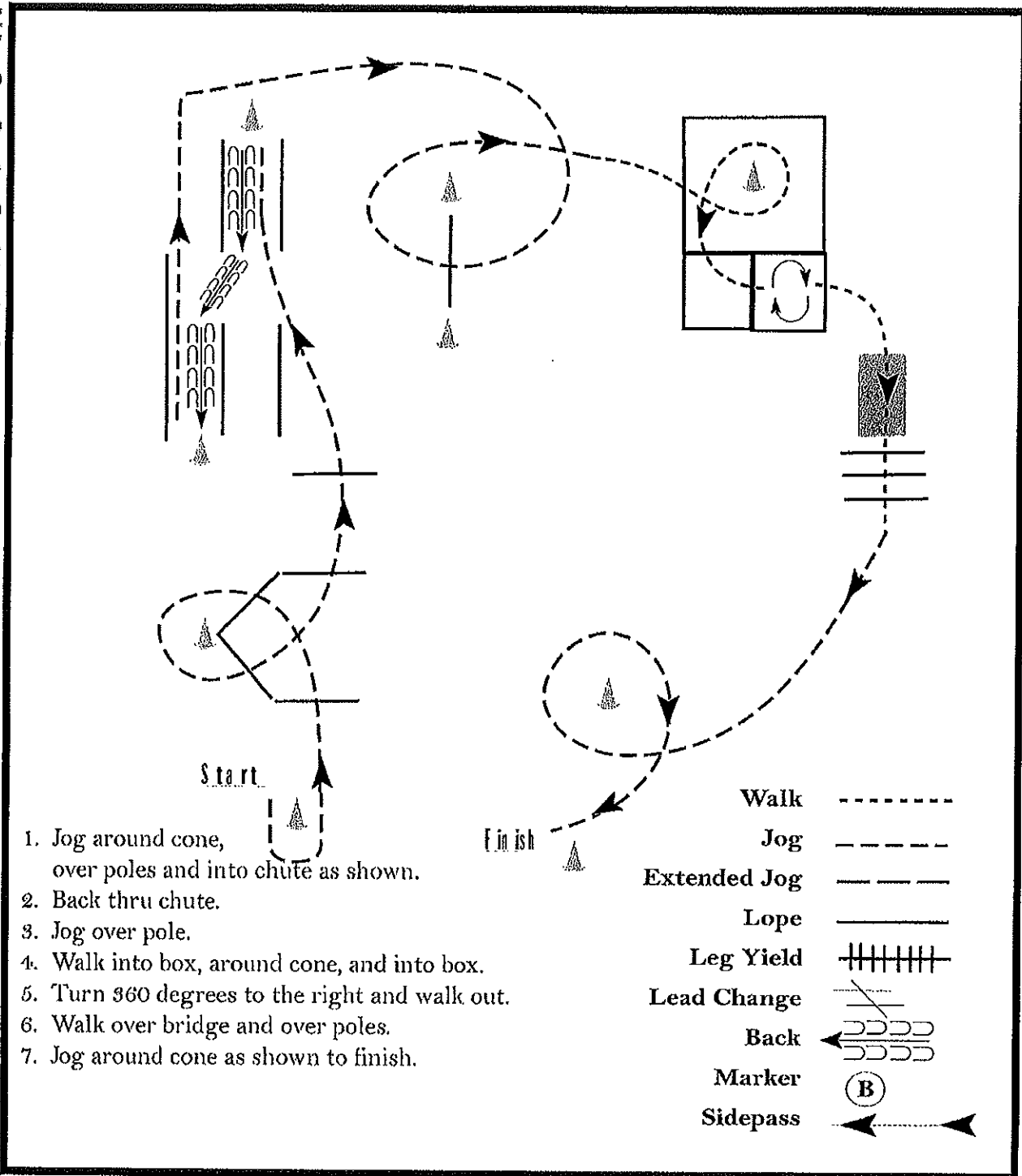

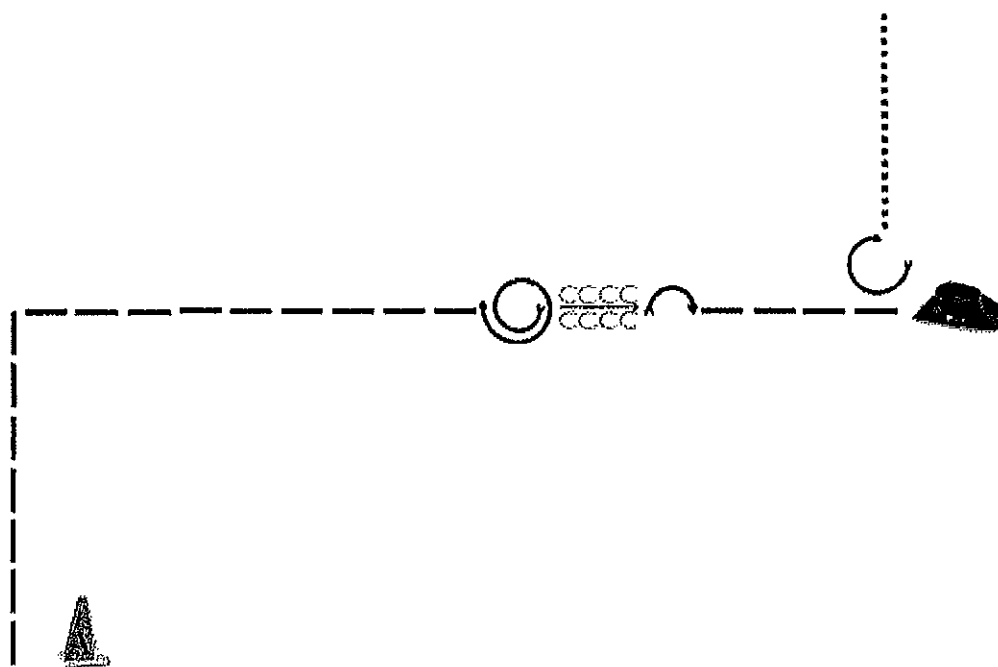
Be Ready at Cone A

- 1) Trot toward judge as show
- 2) Stop and perform a 450' turn
- 3) Trot to judge
- 4) Back one horse length
- 5) Walk to judge and set up for inspection
- 6) When dismissed, perform a 270' turn
- 7) Exit at a walk

Instructions

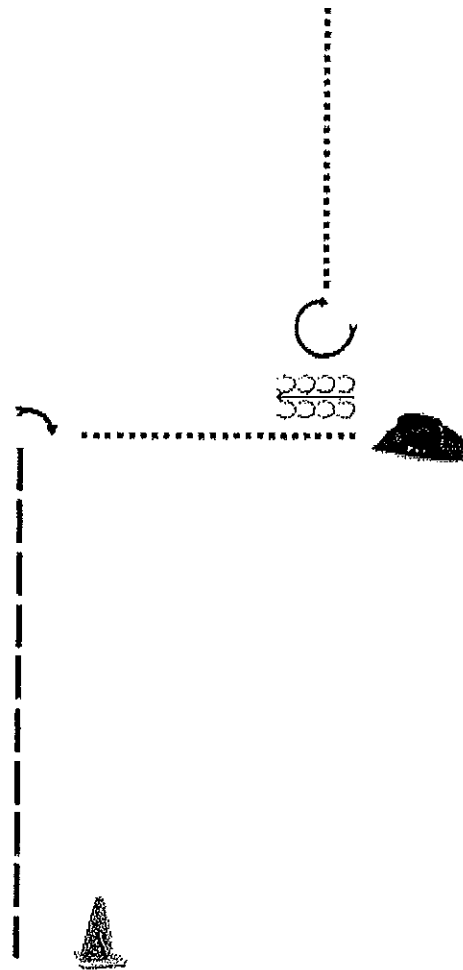
Be Ready at Cone A

- 1) Trot square corner toward judge as show
- 2) Continue trotting halfway to judge
- 3) Stop and perform a 540° turn
- 4) Back one horse length
- 5) Perform a 180° turn and trot to the judge
- 6) Set up for inspection
- 7) When dismissed, perform a 270° turn
- 8) Exit at a walk

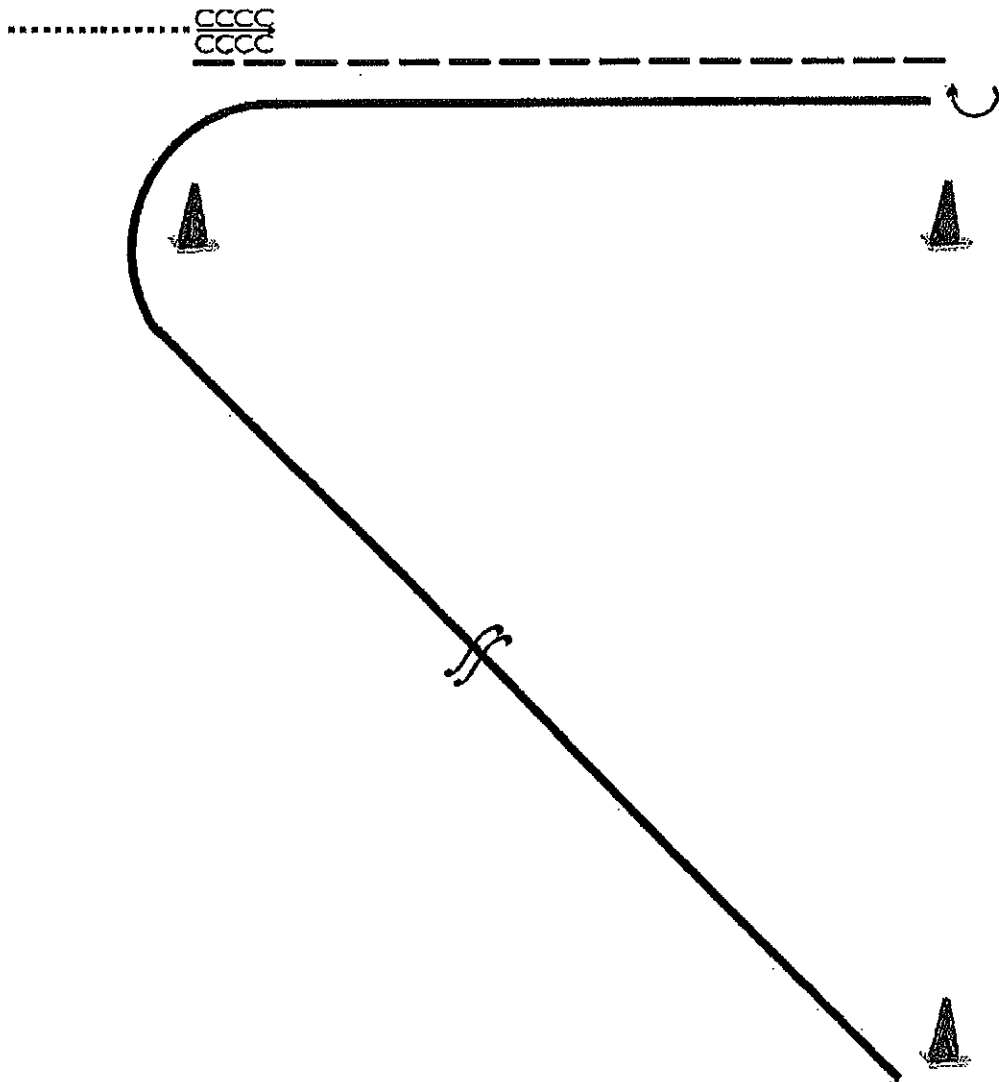

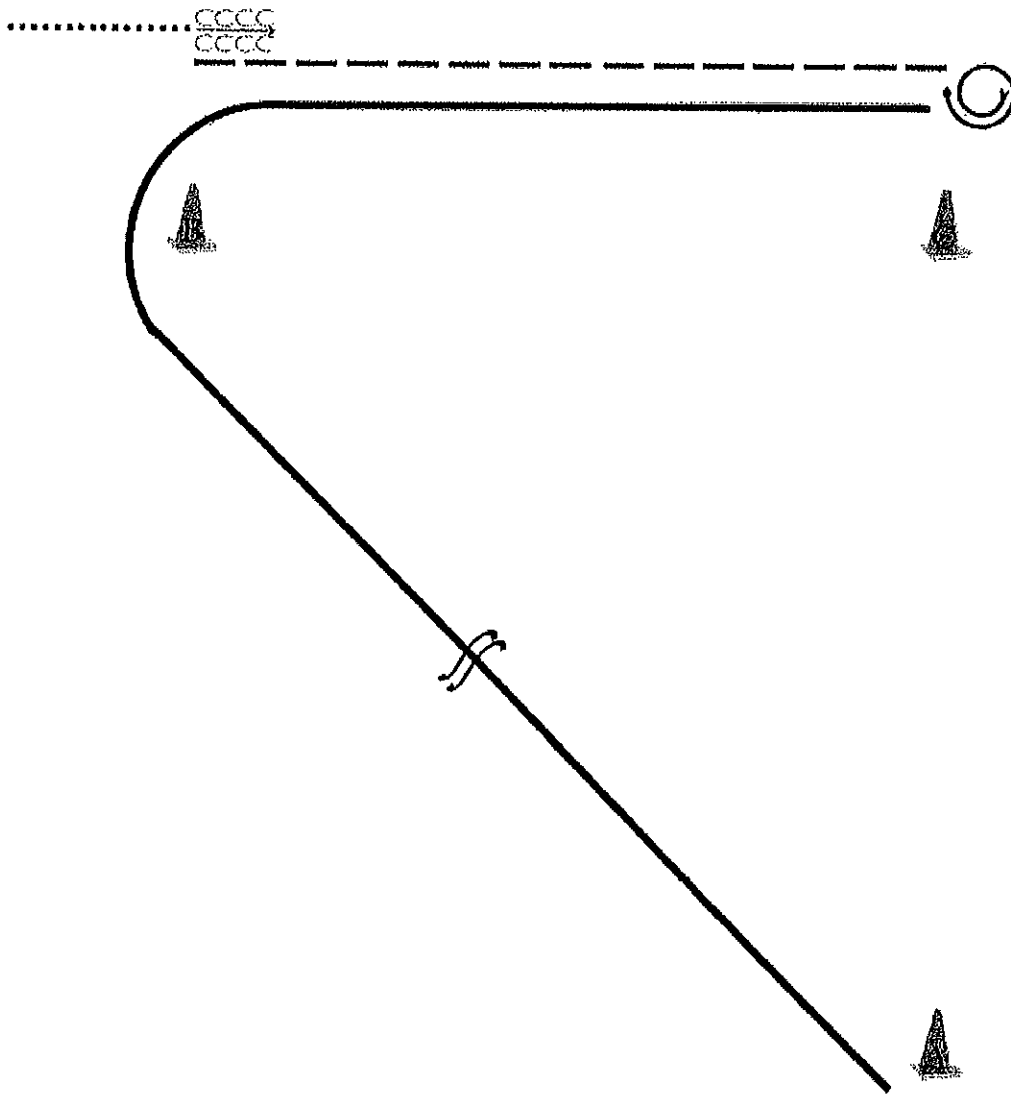
Be Ready at A

- 7) Exit at a walk

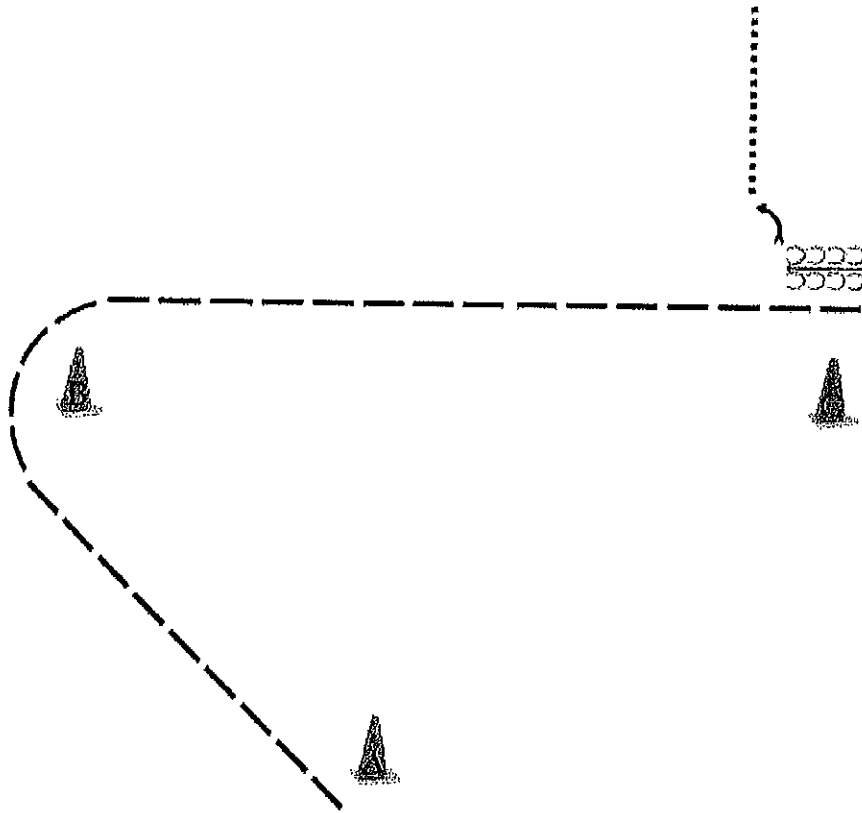

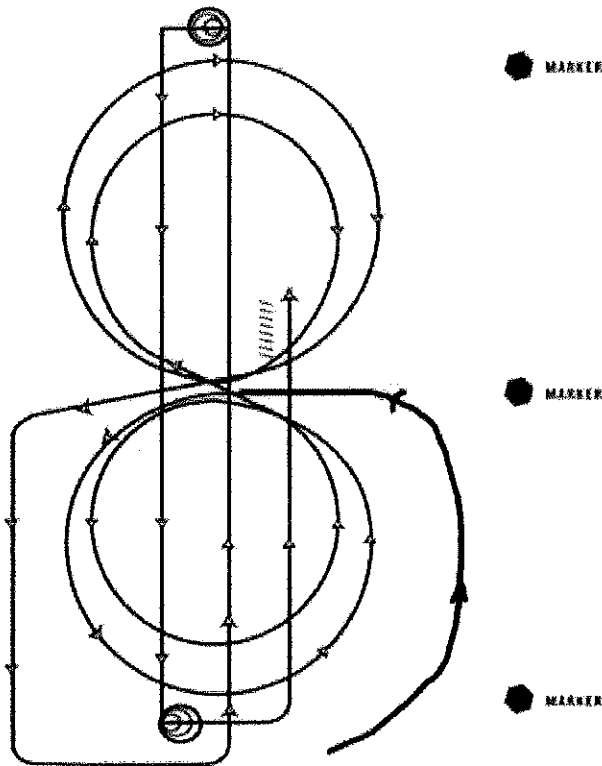

Ranch Reining- All Age Divisions & Classes

**Stock Horse Reining
Pattern 8 -- Lope In**



Mandatory Marker along Fence or Wall

The judge shall indicate with markers on arena fence or wall the center of pattern

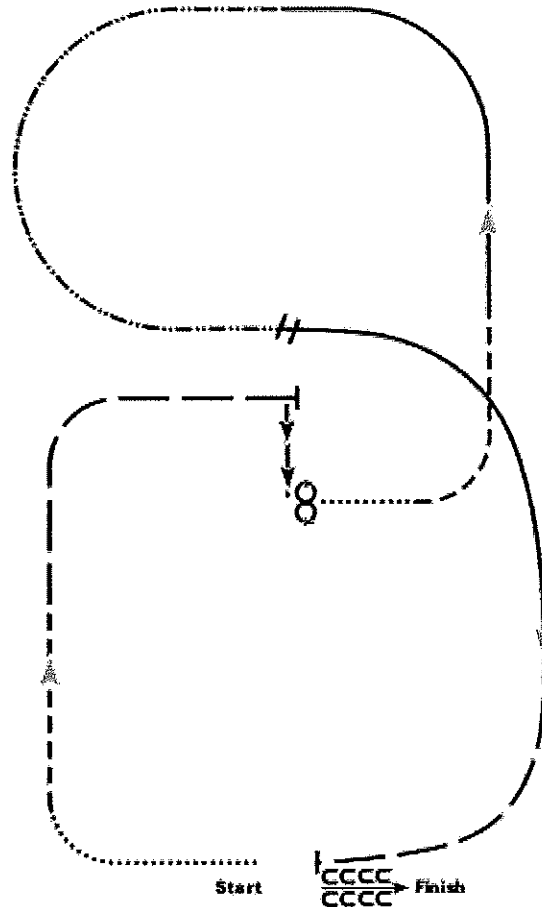
Ride Pattern as follows:

1. As you enter the arena, begin on left lead and lope to the center, without stopping or breaking gait, and begin the pattern
2. Begin on left lead and complete two circles to the left, the first circle large and fast, the second circle small and slow. Change leads to the right
3. Complete two circles to the right, the first circle large and fast, the second circle small and slow. Change leads to the left
4. Continue around the end of arena without breaking gait or changing leads, run down the center of the arena past end marker and execute a square sliding stop
5. Complete 3 ½ spins to the left
6. Run down to other end of arena, past the end marker and execute a square sliding stop
7. Complete 3 ½ spins to the right
8. Run past the center marker and execute a square sliding stop
9. Back at least 10 feet in a straight line
10. Hesitate to complete pattern.

Ranch Riding- All Age Divisions & Classes

Ranch Riding Pattern #3

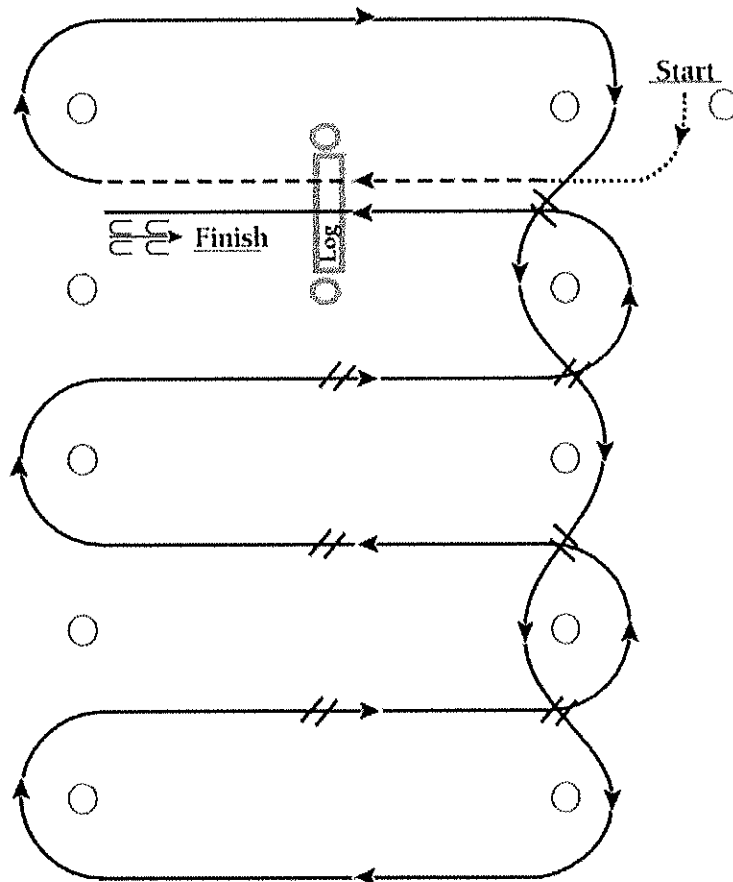


1. Walk to the left around corner of the arena
2. Trot
3. Extend alongside of the arena and around the corner to center
4. Stop, side pass right
5. 360 turn each direction (either way 1st)
6. Walk
7. Trot
8. Lope left lead
9. Extend the lope
10. Change leads (simple or flying)
11. Collect to the lope
12. Extend trot
13. Stop and back

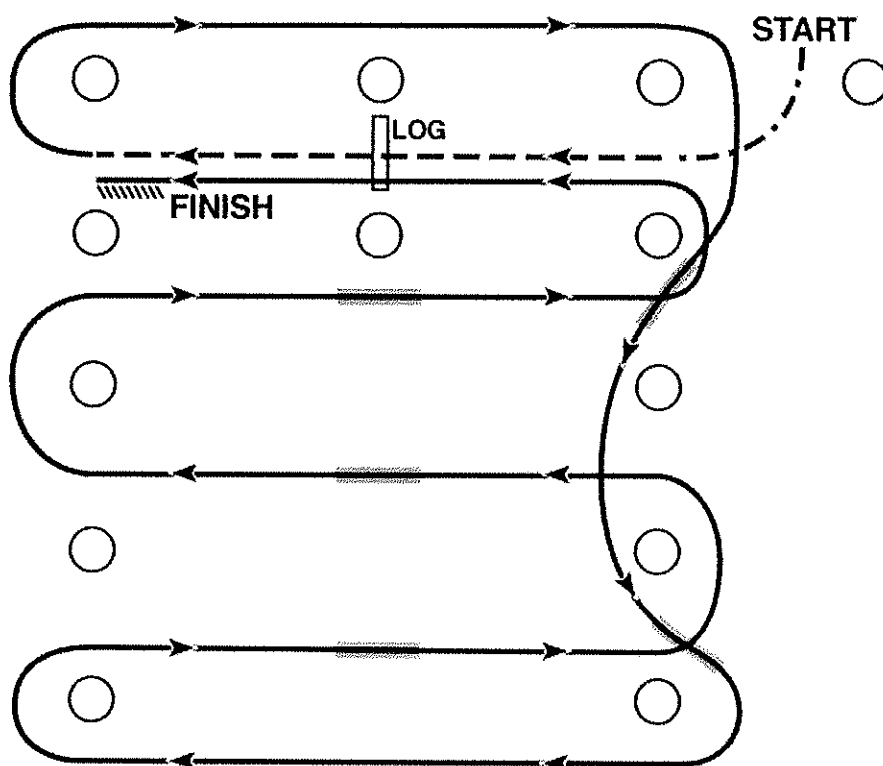
Western Riding Pattern #4



1. Walk, transition to jog, jog over log.
2. Transition to lope, lope to right around end.
3. First line change.
4. Second line change.
5. Third line change.
6. Fourth line change.
7. First crossing change.
8. Second crossing change.
9. Third crossing change.
10. Lope over log.
11. Lope, stop and back.

Green Western Riding Pattern #4



1. Walk, transition to log, jog over log.
2. Transition to right lead and lope around end.
3. First line change.
4. Second line change, lope around end of arena.
5. First crossing change.
6. Second crossing change.
7. Third crossing change.
8. Lope over log.
9. Lope, stop and back.
