

MFAH Professional Development Course for Visual Art Teachers

The Museum of Fine Arts, Houston offers specialized professional development courses for art teachers. At the Art Education Conference and Workshop, participants investigate methods and materials to teach art to students of all levels. Teachers will explore ways of using works from the MFAH collection as a vital part of learning about art. The course integrates art history, studio work, building rubrics, strategies for the development of lessons plans, and classroom management techniques. Teaching models will be presented and discussed. The class is designed for all grade levels of teachers, Pre-K – 12.

Teachers register for an intensive, two-day professional development event that takes place in late July and early August 2020, completing 12 hours of professional development credit. Each participant receives a Certificate of Completion and transcript.
