

The Medical and Safety Committee of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo™, is recognized by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) and the City of Houston as a First Responder, is dedicated to preventing and reducing the extent of injury or illness in the areas of NRG Park under the Rodeo's responsibility, which includes any participant or attendee of the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, the Trail Ride and the World's Championship Bar-B-Que Contest.

The committee is dedicated to keeping the grounds and patrons safe and will utilize professional dispatch emergency calls throughout the run of the show. In case of accidents, we will thoroughly investigate all incidents.

The committee works in conjunction with the city of Houston Fire Department Fire Prevention Command to identify and correct any hazards which could be detrimental or increase the likeliness of injury to the participants and attendees at the Rodeo.

The Medical and Safety Committee is seeking qualified candidates specifically for our Medical Division. Texas licensed medical providers: Licensed Paramedic, EMT-Paramedic, Advanced EMT, EMT-Basic, LVN, RN, APRN or PA-C) may reach out to our recruitment team at recruitment@safetycommittee.org

Our members are required to work 4 - 10hr shifts throughout the rodeo season, and shifts are scheduled based on your availability. Our Medical and Safety Committee dues are \$40/yearly.
