TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

WHO WE ARE:

- The Transportation Committee serves the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo by handling the transportation needs of Show patrons, volunteers, exhibitors and special guests within the grounds of NRG Park safely.
- Operating since 1991, the Transportation Committee (TC) has a long and proud history of service to the Show. At its inception, the committee was approximately 30 volunteers strong and worked with golf carts to shuttle fellow committee and board members around the grounds. As attendance at the Rodeo has increased, so has the need for safe and efficient transportation both on and off site.
- Over the years, the committee has evolved and grown to over 1,800 strong and expanded its coverage and hours of operation to better serve the needs of the show. We currently operate 24 hours a day, utilizing golf carts, mini trams, and tractor pulled carts within the grounds of NRG. In addition, Trams are used to support offsite parking areas in the Yellow Lot off Main Street and Tractor pulled carts support the 610 parking lot. A fleet of automobiles are utilized to facilitate off site transportation as well for special guests, as well as Rodeo officers and directors.

OUR VOLUNTEERS:

- **Cart Drivers** – Carts are utilized to move small groups of visitors safely to their destinations on the grounds. Designated pickup areas are located strategically around the 350 acre plus complex.
- **Grounds Crew** – The real boots on the ground for the TC helps oversee the safe loading and unloading of patrons. Securing seat belts, strollers, and other equipment for transport, securing clear pathways for motorized trams and trailers- all with a smile- helps make it a safe and pleasant experience for everyone.
- **Tram and Tractor Drivers, Conductors** – Driving the big trams and mini trams which help move large groups of people from designated areas. Conductors keep the mood light, answer questions and serve as hosts for those in their care.
- **Cook Team** – An army is said to travel on their stomach, so does TC. Each shift is provided a hot meal and a chance to take a break and enjoy it. The TC Cook Team cooks these meals each shift.
- **Support** – These volunteers work behind the scenes to ensure our operations run smoothly. From member services to asset management, this team makes sure we are organized and prepared for success.
- **Late Night Team** – Our committee runs 24/7, so we have a special team that covers the overnight shift. These teams include cart and mini-tram drivers.
- **Set-Up/Tear-Down** – Part of what makes our committee run smoothly is a well-established homebase. This is where this team comes into play. Before the Rodeo kicks off, they are on grounds making sure everything is ready and they come back after it ends to pack up and store everything for the next year.
