General Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be a citizen of the United States and be a Texas resident
- Graduate from high school during the 2025-2026 school year
- Have made a formal application to enroll with intent to attend a Texas college or university and participate in a curriculum leading to a Bachelor's degree for the 2026-2027 academic year
- Texas college must be:
 - Accredited by The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges
 - Not-for-profit

4-Year, \$20,000 Scholarship



General Eligibility Requirements

Rodeo Scholars may choose to attend a two-year, junior or community college until they reach 60 credit hours. The student must then transfer to a four-year university in pursuit of a Bachelor's Degree.

 Hours earned during high school (dual credit) do not count toward the 60 hour limit.

Metropolitan Scholarships

Awarded Two Ways:

- Weighted on Merit
 - Each public high school with a qualifying student who meets a minimum score is reserved one scholarship
- Weighted on Need
 - Remaining scholarships available after merit-based have been awarded
 - Not reserved per school, includes state charter schools



- SAT and/or ACT Score Report

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Military Dependent:

 Parent/Guardian DD-214 or proof of active military duty

Volunteer Dependent:

 Name and HLSR Member Number of parent/guardian

Contact Information and Data

- Name, Address, Phone Number, and Email
 - This creates their Kaleidoscope account!
- High School Information
 - If school is not listed, reach out to our office!
- Demographic Information
 - Data only, not shared with reviewers
- Financial Aid Essay



4-YEAR, \$20,000 SCHOLARSHIP

Show Participation

- Have you participated in the Show other than livestock/horse shows?
 - Just for data! Includes options like going to the RODEOHOUSTON performance, the parade, or participating in events that are not eligible for the Exhibitor scholarship.
- Are you competing in 2026 Junior Market or Breeding Shows or Horse Shows?
 - Used to determine if student is eligible for the Exhibitor Scholarship
 - Triggers additional essay required for scholarship
 - What does participating at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo mean to you, and how has participating in the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo influenced your educational and career aspirations?
- Are you participating in the 2026 School Art or Quick Draw contest?
 - Used to determine if student is eligible for School Art Scholarship
 - Student provides information about their artwork and sponsoring teacher



4-YEAR, \$20,000 SCHOLARSHIP

Leadership, Extra Curriculur Activities, Volunteer Activities and Awards

- Should be related to high school involvement
- Students may list multiple years for one club/activity
- Maximum of 8 total activities



4-YEAR, \$20,000 SCHOLARSHIP

Community Activities/Work Experience

- Any other activities or work experience
 - Examples: Volunteering through a church group, working a part-time job, babysitting for a neighbor, etc.
- Maximum of 6 activities
